

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
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## **ENVISION**

- Combine the words into 1 drawing




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# UNDERSTAND ART WORLDS

- Examine and critique art



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
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# OBSERVE PRACTICE

- Embrace "mistakes"





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
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# STRETCH & EXPLORE: WET-ON-WET PLANETS

- Put everything away in the right places





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
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# DEVELOP CRAFT: PRACTICE

## **USING WATERCOLOR:**

- Custom color wheel!
- Only use Red, Blue, and Yellow paint
- Clean your brush and studio space





# ENGAGE & PERSIST

I continue to work on personally meaningful projects and stick with them, even when I'm having difficulty or feeling frustrated.

- Connect with and commit to my art
- Use my skills to go deeper
- Stick with my art and problem-solve when challenges come up
- Manage my time to finish my work



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## **EXPRESS**

I create work that tells a story, communicates personal meaning, or shares an idea.

- Communicate my ideas and feelings through my artwork
- Discover and use imagery to convey meaning
- I can interpret meaning in other artists' works

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
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## REFLECT
