
## #3 LOADING



## #1 TRANSPARENCY

- Water determines how transparent or opaque your colors are.

- 3 x 5 squares with different levels of transparency.

## #2 GRADIENTS

- Try to "drag" the puddle of water from left to right while adding more paint
- 2+ gradients of same hue (monochromatic)
- 2+ gradients of 2+ hues (mix in the palette over time)


